4. The conditions of offer are shown in our quotation and our offer does not imply our willingness to enter into a sub-contract agreement containing conditions that differ from our offer.
5. All variations to contract must be made in writing, signed and approved by an authorised representative prior to additional work commencing.
6. Gabba Sporting Products has built its name on quality products & workmanship, all care will be taken whilst working on site. We do not accept any responsibility for any damage to buildings, services or surrounding landscapes as we will be working in conjunction with the property engineers & stakeholders.
7. It is the client's responsibility to mark out boundaries and/or have the boundary surveyed, and services such as Phone, Power, Water & Gas must be located by the client.
8. To facilitate vehicle and machine entry to the site, a suitable path is to be nominated by the client. The client is to provide ground protection mats in place if the path is soft & likely to be damaged.
9. Unless otherwise specified, quotations are based on standard soil conditions for excavation. In the event of rock, hard fill or foreign material being encountered, further costs as required for excavation / earthwork will be applied.

11. All soil lifted during excavation will be moved within the grounds, no soil will be removed from the property, a suitable location will be arranged with the grounds staff prior to excavation work starting.
12. Whilst every effort is made to complete the works within a timely manner, deviation from the anticipated time frame may be encountered in unfavourable weather conditions or where unforeseen obstacles are encountered within the site.
13. Site specific inductions that exceed thirty (30) minutes in length will incur a charge based on our hourly rate.
