Review existing Services drawings and complete a DBYD.

Review GEO Tech and complete structural design for the works

Install temp fence where required around the piers.

90L/m x 10m high of anti-throw netting 40m sq associated posts.

Hydro Excavate the holes to avoid damage to the existing services.

allowance to remove soil offsite - Excluded contaminated soils.

TVN to have a small excavator there to help with small rocks or the like.

Supply and install 13 x 168 x 7.1 x 10m high CHS Posts as per Gabba structural design inc cage & boltset for the footing. Hot Dip Galvanised Posts.

Supply wire runner at the top and bottom for the netting to affix to.

Supply all fixings and buckles for the netting to fix to the wire.

Supply and install 90m x 10m PE40-45 Netting (refer APPENDIX 01 Netting Specification Sheet).

Labour to install the above

EWP Hire & licenced operator to affix the netting

Crane hire to lift the posts into position. inc Methodology.

Allowance to complete Crane Lift Plan as per Serco SOP.

Clean up on completion.

7. It is the client's responsibility to mark out boundaries and/or have the boundary surveyed, and services such as Phone, Power, Water & Gas must be located by the client.
8. To facilitate vehicle and machine entry to the site, a suitable path is to be nominated by the client. The client is to provide ground protection mats in place if the path is soft & likely to be damaged.

11. All soil lifted during excavation will be moved within the grounds, no soil will be removed from the property, a suitable location will be arranged with the grounds staff prior to excavation work starting.
12. Whilst every effort is made to complete the works within a timely manner, deviation from the anticipated time frame may be encountered in unfavourable weather conditions or where unforeseen obstacles are encountered within the site.
13. Site specific inductions that exceed thirty (30) minutes in length will incur a charge based on our hourly rate.
